

God Wants Your Forehead

n the book of Revelation, two very distinct groups of people are brought to our attention.

Curiously, the difference between these two end-time categories of humanity lies in the contents of "their foreheads." The worshipers of the beast have received his "mark in their right hand or in their foreheads" (Revelation 13:16-17). Immediately after this startling insight, John was shown those who "follow the Lamb," Jesus Christ, "having His Father's name written in their foreheads" (Revelation 14:1, 4).

What could possibly be meant by all this concern regarding what lies within people's foreheads? Often referred to as the "frontal lobe," the forehead houses that part of the brain in which we perceive and assess information, pass judgment and make decisions. Into the forehead beliefs are downloaded, by which emotions are ignited, from which actions are executed. In turn, the beliefs that originated those actions are reinforced. With each repeated action, the shape of one's mind is more firmly set. Character is formed by the wonderful process of thinking, feeling, deciding and acting. In this

way identity is established and destiny determined.

Deep within the human subconscious a law of reflection continually operates, whether we know it or not, understand it or not, or can explain it or not. If the law of gravity states, "What goes up, must come down," the law of reflection says, "What goes in, must come out." Said another way, we reflect in behavior what we believe at heart. God created this law within us for our benefit, as a necessary psychological principle for the development of His selfless love in all our relationships. He engineered the human mind in such a way that we would reflect to others the love we first see in Him. Then, as we would experience His love being reflected back to us through others, our own capacity for love would grow and deepen. However, while all laws of divine origin were designed to lavish blessing upon us, the violation of those good laws cannot but result in harmful effects. The law of reflection is no exception. Whether good or evil, lies or the truth, we reflect what we see and believe to be true. The power of choice is powerful indeed. As free moral agents we ultimately do get

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what we choose. What I choose to believe, even if it is false to reality, is true for me in effect. If I believe that God stands toward me in an attitude of condemnation, that's how I will feel Him acting toward me and I will behave accordingly toward others. If I believe that God does not love me. I will feel that He does not love me. Then I will act as though He does not love me and find it difficult to love others. There is a straight line of vital cause and effect relationship between thoughts, feelings, behavior, character formation and destiny. We act out behaviorally what we feel emotionally, and we feel emotionally what we believe theologically. What we think determines how we feel, determines how we behave, determines the person we become. Theology yields emotional response, yields behavioral patterns, vield character. We reflect what we see and believe about God. Said Solomon's way, "As a man thinketh in his heart, so is he."

Conclusion?

What we believe about God really matters.

We will be sealed or marked accordingly.

I was shown men and women studying with intense interest papers and a few pages of tracts upon present truth. They would read the evidences

so wonderful and new to them, and would open their Bibles with a deep and new interest, as subjects of truth that had been dark to them were made plain, especially the light in regard to the Sabbath of the fourth commandment. As they searched the Scriptures to see if these things were so, a new light shone upon their understanding, for angels were hovering over them, and impressing their minds with the truths contained in the publications they had been reading.

I saw them holding papers and tracts in one hand, and the Bible in the other, while their cheeks were wet with tears: and bowing before God in earnest, humble prayer, to be guided into all truth,--the very thing He was doing for them before they called upon Him. JESUS ISTHE ANSWER

A Report on the Pretoria, South Africa Evangelistic Campaign with Herry Mhando



Pretoria will never, ever be the same again. It all started with a discussion with one of the pastors from Zimbabwe about the idea of forever changing South Africa, as far as evangelism is concerned.

A name came up, and it was the name of one, Pastor Herry Mhando, who works with Light Bearers Ministry under the Tanzania Union. It came out that Dr. Mhando was holding a campaign in Kenya. Immediately, a telephone call was made and the man was on the line. We made an appointment to go to Kenya to invite him. The trip was made and it was agreed that he would come to South Africa this year— 2006. The dates were set and arrangements were made. The challenge was to convince the churches in South Africa that this would be a campaign that would make a difference. People did not know Herry Mhando, neither did they know about the man's unique methods of evangelism. By the grace of God, some people were convinced through the workings of the Holy Spirit. Targeting influential people whom we would use to motivate the other church members, we managed to put together a committee comprising people from different churches.

Week by week we started witnessing miracles: the acquisition of the venue, the number of people who started coming forward with a willingness to assist. We became more and more convinced that this campaign was indeed the work of God.

The support that we received from Light Bearers Ministry in the form of literature is so amazing. Surely, this ministry is touching and changing the world forever.

Then the opening day of the event arrived. It was a day when we expected a few interested people to come. To our surprise, the stadium had more that 2000 people. It was the Sabbath day. God works in mighty ways. The atmosphere was so amazing and we started feeling a bit more comforted that as long as people had come on the first day, then it could only get better. Night after night we witnessed good attendance, but the Sabbath days were the most glorious.

As night after night passed, we started witnessing testimonies of healing and deliverance from all sorts of problems. At first people started questioning the "new religion" that was being presented. Healing? Miracles? In the Adventist church? What are you talking about? This was the attitude. But God was revealing Himself. As people started to see their own relatives and themselves receiving healing, the attitude suddenly changed. People started talking freely and praising God for the liberation that had come to Pretoria. As organizers, we started getting congratulatory messages for having organized such a unique crusade.

The president of the Conference attended one session. The man of God

was never the same again. On that day the conference pledged financial support. That was the beginning of big things. What changed the Conference president was that his grandson, who had a heart problem was healed through the prayers. The executive secretary of the Union was the next to come. He and his wife would never to be the same again. Next to come was the Southern Africa-Indian Ocean Division President, Pastor Rastara. It was his first contact with Herry Mhando. The moment he met Dr Mhando, Pastor Rastara was deeply moved. The man of God could not let go of Dr. Mhando. Pastor Rastara invited him to his hotel where they spent half the night talking. This was the beginning of many meetings and countless telephone calls that the Division president made to Dr. Mhando talking of big plans for evangelism in South Africa. An invitation to Dr. Mhando to conduct a conference wide campaign was made by both the Division president and the Conference president. This event is going to be held in 2007 as part of the General Conference Big Cities Evangelism program.

As weeks went by, Dr. Mhando's house became like a hospital. There were many people waiting to see him on a daily basis. One amazing point about next year's campaign is that the Conference has decided to hire a helicopter to transport Dr. Mhando from one area to another and make sure that in the evenings he will be back in time for the service in Pretoria.

The support that we received from Light Bearers Ministry in the form of literature is so amazing. Surely, this ministry is touching and changing the world forever. Requesting literature was not a big problem. Just a single e-mail to Brother James Rafferty is all that it took—and the materials were shipped to South Africa. May God bless this powerful ministry.

In conclusion, I wish to talk about the powerful baptisms that were conducted every Sabbath. In South Africa if you baptize 20 people after 3 weeks of evangelistic campaign, it will be talked about for the whole year. The first week we baptized more that 35 people. About 200 people were baptized by the end of the crusade. South Africa will never be the same again. There were many testimonies of healing from cancer, diabetes, HIV and other chronic diseases.

The last Sabbath was glorious where more than 6000 people attended the
