You know how sometimes when you read a familiar Bible verse you see something you never saw before? It is especially exciting when it occurs in relation to a section of the Bible that is somewhat basic, like Revelation 15:

“And I saw as it were a sea of glass mingled with fire: and them that had gotten the victory over the beast, and over his image, and over his mark, and over the number of his name, stand on the sea of glass, having the harps of God. And they sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, Great and marvellous are thy works, Lord God Almighty; just and true are thy ways, thou King of saints. Who shall not fear thee, O Lord, and glorify thy name? for thou only art holy: for all nations shall come and worship before thee; for

thy judgments are made manifest” (Revelation 15:2-4).

The song of Moses and the Lamb, a song sung by people who have experienced God’s saving grace that gives them victory over the beast, his image, mark and name. Pretty basic. Yet I had never seen the connection of their victory song to the three angels’ message of Revelation 14:6-7:

“And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people, Saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.”

Look at this powerful connect! The call of the everlasting gospel is to:

- Fear God

- Give glory to Him
 - For the hour of His judgment is come
 - And to worship Him
- Those who get the victory over the beast, who sing the song of Moses and the Lamb say:
- Who shall not fear Thee
 - And glorify Thy name
 - For Thy judgments are made manifest
 - And all nations shall come and worship before Thee

The song of Moses and the Lamb is a song of an experience in the message of the three angels! The good news of that message reveals an awesome God Who is worthy of our deepest trust and truest worship because He only has always selflessly done what is right and best for all. And those who accept the embrace of this Love will ever sing it’s song. Amen.

A Powerful New Way To Witness

What if you had a library of short, well-crafted video messages that you could share from your computer to anyone else by simply clicking your send button? Well, with digma.com, you now have exactly that. Digma.com is a mass communication project via short video messages. It's like handing out truth-filled tracts door to door, only it's handing out truth-filled videos computer to computer.

Here's how it works. You just go to digma.com. There you will find at your command a building library of free videos. First, view them for your own spiritual growth. Second, just click on any video, type in an email address and a personal message: "Hey Michael, we were talking the other day about creation and evolution (or what happens when we die, or why we suffer if God is good, etc). Here's a short video on the topic that I found interesting and helpful. Hope you enjoy it. Have a great day." Then click send. In a matter of seconds, Michael receives the video right in his email inbox along with your personal

note. He simply clicks on the video icon in your email and immediately his browser opens to the website and plays the video. The video is short, just 5 to 7 minutes, so it's easy to watch, but the information is powerful, precise and thought provoking. If Michael finds it interesting, he's already at the website and sees that there are other videos to watch. Video by video, one bite of information at a time, the truth is unfolded to him. It's that easy.

Besides emailing them to people, there are three other ways you can use the digma videos:

1. You can upload any, or all, of the digma videos to your own Facebook page for your friends to view and comment upon.
2. You can buy them on DVDs for sharing with those who do not use the Internet.
3. You can show them as discussion starters in your home Bible study group or in your church.

Quite simply, you have never seen any sharing tool like this.

And if you're wondering why we call this project digma.com, it's because digma is a Greek word that

means, to show or reveal something as a pattern or example. It's the second half of the word paradigma, from which we get the English word paradigm, as in paradigm shift. And that's what these videos are all about. They are designed to lead our friends and family on an exciting paradigm shift by revealing the truth of God's existence, His creative power and His incredibly beautiful character in contrast to our world's popular misconceptions about who God is. And besides that, digma is easy to spell and easy to remember. So check it out today and check back regularly for new video messages.
